CONFIDENTIAL REPORTING POLICY

The Scottish Police Services Authority has a duty to conduct its affairs in a responsible and transparent way taking account of the requirement to ensure the proper use of public funds and of the standards required in public life.

This policy is designed to allow staff to raise concerns or information which they believe in good faith provides evidence of malpractice or impropriety. Individuals discovering apparent evidence of malpractice, impropriety or wrongdoing within the Scottish Police Services Authority should be able to disclose the information appropriately, confidentially and without fear of reprisal.
