## HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

The Chief Executive of the Scottish Police Services Authority is fully committed to the health and safety of all employees of the organisation and the manner in which it conducts its activities.

It is the policy of the Scottish Police Services Authority to ensure, *so far as is reasonably practicable*, the provision and maintenance of:

- Safe and healthy working conditions, equipment and systems of work for all employees of the organisation; and
- Such resources, information, training and supervision as is needed for these purposes.

The Scottish Police Services Authority also accepts its responsibilities for the health and safety of other people who may be affected by its activities.

To this end, the Scottish Police Services Authority will comply with the requirements of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, all other relevant statutory provisions and recognised Codes of Practice. The Chief Executive expects all personnel, employed by or seconded to the organisation, to co-operate fully in the achievement of this policy.

Contractors and their employees will be required to comply with the policy and other relevant statutory requirements when on the premises or carrying out work for the organisation.
